CGDM -Domestic Mission Grant Application 2017

Attached are the procedures by which your parish may request support for Domestic Mission Initiatives. All Commission for Global & Domestic Mission (CGDM) projects are funded through the Diocesan Budget to support mission projects outside the Diocese. "Domestic" includes the United States and its territories.

The Commission for Global & Domestic Mission, which recommends to the Diocesan Council & Bishop Hollingsworth the projects to be funded, must *receive* your completed Grant Application no later than **August 31, 2017**. The attached pages make clear the initial information CGDM needs in order to make decisions about funding. If more information is needed, a CGDM member will get in touch with the parish contact person given in the Application.

CGDM anticipates that requests will be made by parishes on behalf of agencies or projects with which they have some active connection, either because of work they support with hands-on service by parish members or because of their own donations, whether in dollars or in-kind donations.

DOMESTIC MISSION INITIATIVES

Domestic mission initiatives *outside* of the Diocese of Ohio may use the Grant Application procedures that follow to apply for grants from CGDM. (*Congregations seeking funds to support mission initiatives that are mainly carried out **within** the Diocese of Ohio should apply for a grant from Episcopal Community Services, which may be found at this link: <http://dohio.org/episcopal-community-services>.)*

To be eligible for a grant from CGDM, Domestic Mission Initiatives must relate to the "Eleven Essentials of Justice" set out in this Episcopal Church document (page 13):

Grant Application Procedures

- I. Applications must be in written form addressed to the Commission for Global & Domestic Mission. The application is limited to no more than 2 pages with a font-size of 12 or larger (additional pages will not be evaluated).

- II. Applications must include the following information:
 1. The name of the project
 2. The nature and scope of its work
 3. The length of time the project has been in existence
 4. The proper mailing address for the project to receive donations
 5. The address and /or website where information about the project can be obtained
 6. A brief statement of the connection between the parish and diocese and the project for which funds are requested—for example, Parish X's involvement with the project, from mission trips taken by its members, or longstanding relationships between the parish and a particular domestic agency
 7. A parish contact person's name, address, phone, and e-mail (if any)
 8. Which of the Essentials of Justice are addressed and how?
 9. What specific activities or aspects of the project will diocesan grant funds support?
 10. Amount of the grant application. (Grants will range from \$500 to \$1,000)
 11. How the fruitfulness or effectiveness of the project will be measured
 12. Date you submitted your Notice of Effectiveness Report for a grant awarded in 2016

- III. **Grant recipients for 2017** must submit a Notice of Effectiveness Report or results to the Commission for Global and Domestic Mission in care of Ms. Antoinette Taylor, ataylor@dohio.org sent to the above address, to be ***received no later than June 30, 2018***.
