CGDM Global Mission Grant Application

Attached are the procedures by which your parish may request support for Global Mission Initiatives to be funded in support of the Millennium Development Goals or the Sustainable Development Goals. All Commission for Global & Domestic Mission (CGDM) projects are funded through the Diocesan Budget to support mission projects outside the Diocese.

The Commission for Global & Domestic Mission, which recommends to the Diocesan Council & Bishop Hollingsworth the projects to be funded, will award Global Mission grant monies on a quarterly basis. CGDM must *receive* your completed Grant Application no later than **March 31, June 30, September 30 and/or December 31 of each year**. The attached pages make clear the initial information CGDM needs in order to make decisions about funding. If more information is needed, a CGDM member will get in touch with the parish contact person given in the Application.

CGDM anticipates that requests will be made by parishes on behalf of agencies or projects with which they have some active connection, either because of work they support with hands-on service by parish members or because of their own donations, whether in dollars or in-kind donations.

GLOBAL MISSION INITIATIVES

CGDM welcomes applications having to do with Global Mission Initiatives from any part of the globe. For all ministry initiatives in the Diocese of Tanga, Tanzania, or the Diocese of Belize, applications must have a letter of endorsement from the Chair of the Tanga Partnership Committee or the Belize Partnership Committee, respectively. Due to the nature of international communications, the Applicant should engage the appropriate Chair in discussions about their initiative well before the Application Due Date. The respective Chair will then be responsible for coordinating that the project has the required support of the local Diocesan Bishop before a grant award will be made.

Goal 16. Promote peaceful and inclusive societies for sustainable development, provide access to justice for all and build effective, accountable and inclusive institutions at all levels

Goal 17. Strengthen the means of implementation and revitalize the global partnership for sustainable development

Remember that applications must be **RECEIVED NO LATER THAN March 31, June 30, September 30 and/or December 31**. Applications received late will be considered in the following quarter.

Applications received after Dec. 31 may not be considered.

Grant Application Procedures

- I. Applications must be in written form addressed to the Commission for Global & Domestic Mission. The application should be no more than 2 pages with a font-size of 11.5 or larger.
- II. Applications must include the following information :
 1. The name of the project
 2. The nature and scope of its work
 3. The length of time the project has been in existence
 4. The proper mailing address for the project to receive donations
 5. The address and /or website where information about the project can be obtained
 6. A brief statement of the connection between the parish and diocese and the project for which funds are requested- for example, Parish X's involvement with the project , from mission trips taken by its members, or longstanding relationships between the parish and a particular domestic agency
 7. A parish contact person 's name, address, phone, and e-mail (if any)
 8. Which MDGs or SDGs is this Application addressing?
 9. What specific activities or aspects of the project will diocesan grant funds support?
 10. Amount of the grant application. (Grants will range from \$1,000 to \$4,000)
 11. How the fruitfulness or effectiveness of the project will be measured
 12. Date you submitted your Notice of Effectiveness Report for a grant awarded in 2016
- III. Grant recipients must submit a Notice of Effectiveness Report or results to the Commission for Global and Domestic Mission in care of Ms. Antoinette Taylor, grants@dohio.org or send to the above address, to be *received no later than 6 months after receiving the grant.*
