2020 BISHOP'S ANNUAL APPEAL

Dear friend and colleague,

The Bishop's Annual Appeal provides valued resources to live more fully into our vocation as the body of Christ. Last year the Appeal raised over a quarter of a million dollars, thanks to the generosity of more than 550 households. \$100,000 of that went directly to Episcopal Community Services (ECS) to support parish-based ministries serving local communities. These important outreach efforts feed the hungry, educate children and young adults, provide spiritual freedom for people who are in prison, give hope to those who are struggling, and offer critical assistance to those in need.

Funds raised through the Appeal also help to underwrite mission trips and leadership development. They provide summer internships for high school and college students. They support our students in residential seminaries, as well as in our distance learning collaboration with Bexley Seabury Seminary. They help provide positions for newly ordained clergy in contexts where they can be challenged and their ministries can flourish.

Most importantly, each gift deepens the donor's identity as a disciple of Jesus. By participating with others in Christ's work of mercy and justice, we take our place in the body of Christ and grow in our vocation to be Christian. Thus, it is through our gifts that we are able to bring blessing to the lives of so many, and through our giving that we are blessed, ourselves.

In June of this year, we will come to the end of the redemption period for pledges to the Planting for Tomorrow Campaign. For some, the 2020 Bishop's Appeal may provide an opportunity to continue the discipline of generous giving established in Planting for Tomorrow. I thank you in advance for giving it your prayerful consideration.
